All Flu Vacc Certificates – including name of horse and microchip number must be emailed to <a href="mailto:Brc16flu@gmail.com">Brc16flu@gmail.com</a> Please also include Rider's name and Club when e-mailing Flu Vacc Certificates.

All vaccinations must conform to current 2020 BRC Handbook Rules – including the 6 month + 21 day requirement. Therefore the latest vaccination date must be no earlier than 27<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

## **RULES**:

- 1 The Qualifier will be run in accordance with BRC 2020 Competition Rules.
- 2 Dress as per Competition Rules.
- 3 Competitors must wear the correct standard hats Rule G22.2 refers.
- 4 A BETA level 3 body protector that has a **Purple 2009 or Blue 2018 label** must be worn. The only exception being Exo Body Cage 2000 **Rule G22.3.** refers.
- 4 Stop Watches must not be used.
- 5 Health & safety and Corvid-19 regulations must be adhered to at all times.
- 6 Hair must be neatly secured and must <u>not</u> hang lower than the shoulder line (when standing normally).
- 7 Only competitors may work in a horse/pony before a class.
- 8 No horses to be left unattended tied to horseboxes/trailers.
- **9** Cars to be parked in the allocated area only.
- 10 Please do not leave litter or muck outside your horsebox on the parking area.
- 14 Children under 16 years old must not be left unattended in a vehicle.
- **15** Dogs to be left in vehicle.
- 16 Competition numbers are required to be provided by Competitor, along with x-c bib.

**TEAM MANAGERS** – The Qualifier will take place using the current Covid 19 Government guidelines and as applied by BRC.

Please ensure ALL competitors comply with the following instructions. Competitors who fail to do so will result in being eliminated from the Qualifier, irrespective of whether they may have competed – or not.

Please ask Competitors to respect and obey any instructions given by a BRC Area 16 Official.

Once the competitor has completed their class / classes they are to leave the venue as soon as possible, as no results will be posted on the day and rosettes will be distributed later.

Senior Competitors will be permitted to only bring one "helper / groom with them.

Junior Competitors may have no more than two helpers – including the person who drove them to the Qualifier.

Grooms / Helpers are to stay with vehicle whilst Competitor is at Warm-up / Competition Arenas.

In the warm-up arena a Steward only will be permitted to raise or lower poles for ALL competitors. The number of Competitors in the warm-up arena will be controlled and restricted to conform to current guidelines.

The number of Competitors in the warm-up arena will be controlled and have restricted numbers to conform to current guidelines.

Competitors should not arrive on site before 1 hour of their class (first class) starting.

Please inform your members - Anyone arriving after their allocated time will not be permitted to compete.

Please respect all current Social Distancing guidelines.

NO SPECTATORS WILL BE PERMITTED.

Results will be posted on BRC Area 16 Social Media pages.
